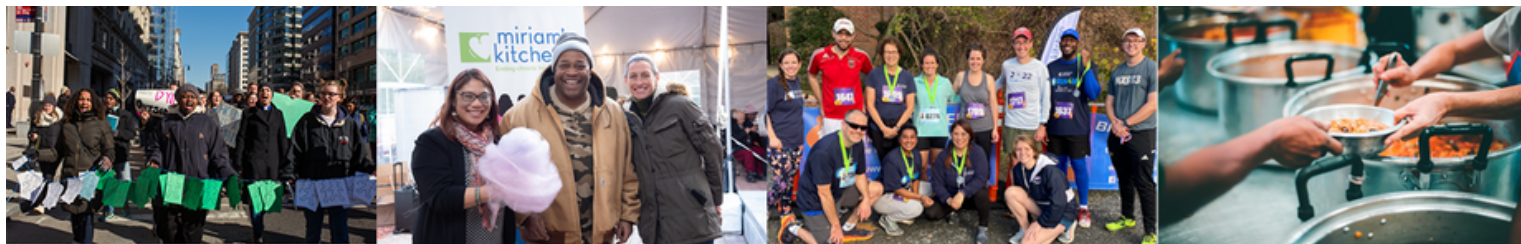

FROM MEALS TO HOUSING TO JUSTICE





about MK

Miriam's Kitchen began in 1983 serving meals to the hungry and unhoused. Over the years, it has evolved its mission from serving those experiencing homelessness to changing the system and ending chronic and veteran homelessness in Washington, DC.

We do this through a multi-prong approach starting with meals and case management services to meet the immediate needs of our guests; helping guests apply for housing and supporting them so they stay housed, and advocating for system change to end homelessness in our nation's capitol.

what we do

MEALS

Our Kitchen Team produces 300 meals each day with security and sustainability in mind. Each meal contains approximately 1200-1500 calories since for some it is the only meal they receive that day. Over the course of a year we anticipate 75,000 meals served.

SOCIAL SERVICES

Our Social Services Team creates pathways for individuals experiencing homelessness to find housing security. This comes in the form of submitting documentation, increasing financial awareness and income, stabilizing health and wellness, and supporting individuals as they review apartments and move into their first home in what might be years.

STREET OUTREACH

Our Outreach Team meets individuals experiencing homelessness where they are. Whether under a bridge, on a bench, or in a park, our team covers nearly half (33/68 square miles of DC), supporting individuals on their path toward housing. This comes in the form of connecting individuals to housing resources and providing supplies to individuals who are still unhoused.

PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING (PSH)

Our PSH team supports individuals who are now housed: reestablishing links to the community, fostering goal setting and healthy living, and ensuring those individuals who experienced homelessness do not fall back into it.

SYSTEM ADVOCACY

Our Advocacy Team impacts at the system level. By examining the systems that affect homelessness and building coalitions and relationships with leaders, we cut through the red tape that keeps individuals from exiting homelessness efficiently, equitably, and expediently.
