Miriam's Kitchen began as a soup kitchen in 1983, serving meals to our unhoused neighbors. Over the years, we have evolved our mission from meal service only to providing comprehensive social services including housing, case management, and antihomelessness advocacy in Washington, D.C. This work ensures everyone has a safe place to call home regardless of the season of life they may be experiencing.



At Miriam's Kitchen, it starts with a meal, but the goal is housing.

What we do

For 40 years, Miriam's Kitchen has served as a trusted resource to those experiencing food and housing insecurity. Your support helps us bring people home. No matter the time of year or season of life, housing is the foundation upon which our guests rebuild their lives. The programs offered at Miriam's Kitchen connect people to housing and healthcare resources which give them new leases on life.

Meals

Our Kitchen Team produces 400 meals each day with security and sustainability in mind. Each meal contains approximately 1200-1500 calories since for some, it is the only meal they receive that day. Over the course of a year, we anticipate 75,000 meals served.

Social Services

Our Social Services Team creates pathways for individuals experiencing homelessness to find housing security. This comes in the form of submitting documentation; increasing financial awareness and income; stabilizing health and wellness; and supporting individuals as they review apartments and end what could be years of being unhoused.

Street Outreach

Our Outreach Team meets individuals experiencing homelessness where they are. Our team covers nearly half of DC (33 out of 68 square miles), supporting individuals on their path toward housing. This comes in the form of connecting individuals to housing resources and providing supplies to individuals who are still unhoused.

Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)

Our PSH team supports individuals who are now housed by helping to reestablish links to the community, foster goal-setting and healthy living, and ensure those individuals do not repeat the cycle of homelessness.

System Advocacy

Our Advocacy Team disrupts inequitable systems that cause homelessness by building coalitions, and relationships with leaders that assist us in eliminating the red tape that keeps individuals from gaining housing efficiently, equitably, and expediently.
